## Emissions reduction targets

In order to continue our progress to achieving Net Zero, we have adopted the following carbon reduction targets:

1. **Carbon Footprint Assessment:** We will conduct a comprehensive assessment of our carbon footprint, including the direct and indirect greenhouse gas emissions generated by our operations. This assessment will cover areas such as energy consumption, waste management, transportation, and procurement. The data collected will serve as a baseline to measure our progress and identify areas for improvement.
2. **Energy Efficiency:** We will strive to reduce our energy consumption by implementing energy-efficient practices across our facilities. This includes the use of LED lighting, energy-efficient appliances, and the installation of programmable thermostats to optimize heating and cooling. We will also encourage staff members and trainees to adopt energy-saving habits, such as turning off lights and equipment when not in use.
3. **Renewable Energy:** Where feasible and economically viable, we will transition to renewable energy sources to power our facilities. This may involve installing solar panels, investing in wind energy, or procuring renewable energy from certified providers. 6. **Carbon Offsetting:** Recognizing that it may not be possible to eliminate all greenhouse gas emissions immediately, we will invest in high-quality carbon offset projects. These projects may include reforestation initiatives, renewable energy projects, or investments in energy-efficient technologies. We will care-fully select carbon offset projects that align with recognized standards and are independently verified.
7. **Education and Awareness:** We will promote environmental awareness and sustainable practices among our staff members, trainees, and clients. We will pro-vide training on sustainability topics, such as energy conservation and waste reduction, to empower individuals to make environmentally conscious choices. We will also share information about our carbon neutrality efforts and encourage dialogue and feedback from all stakeholders.
8. **Continuous Improvement:** We are committed to continuously improving our environmental performance. We will regularly monitor and evaluate the effectiveness of our carbon neutrality measures and adjust our strategies as needed. We will set measurable targets, track our progress, and report on our achievements transparently.

We project that carbon emissions will decrease over the next five years to 27.56 tCO<sub>2</sub>e by 2027. This is a reduction of 12.5%

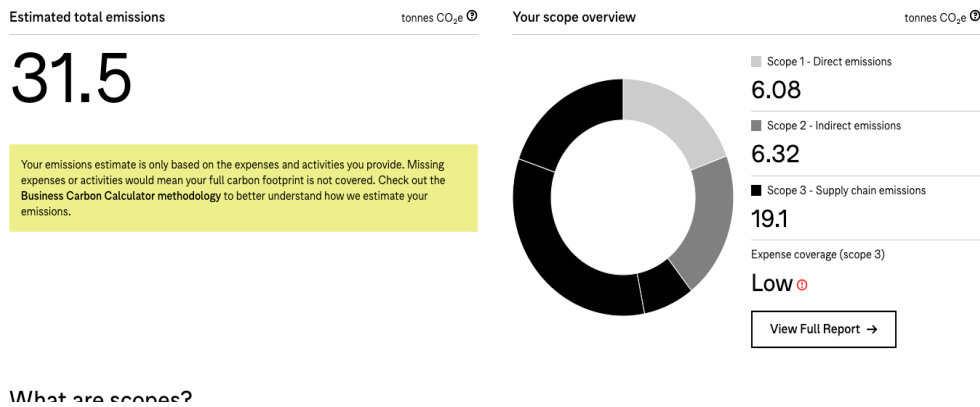


